Cruise Meeting

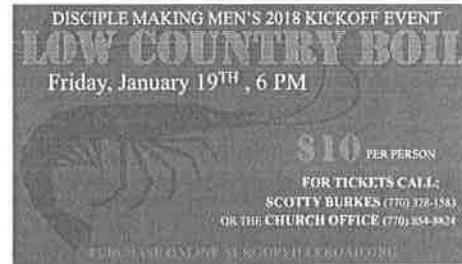
