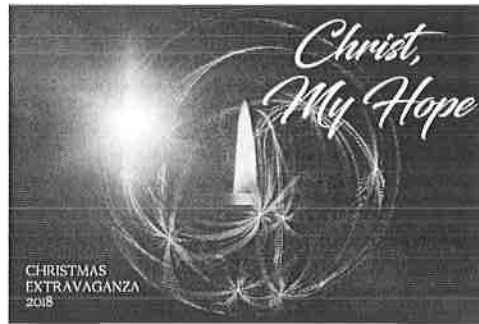
RRBC's Knives for Sale Deadline to Order & Pay is Next Sunday
